The entries are considered the best of the best and they are three-year-old Holstein cows either black and white or red and white. This year there were thirty-five entries and their handlers are also the best of the best.

“I didn’t think I would win,” said Sara Feldmann, Futurity winner with her entry Cow-Palace Atwood Gracie. “I was very surprised.”

“I figured she would be in the top three but you don’t ever really let yourself imagine that she would be the winner,” said Ron Roskopf, owner of Cow-Palace Atwood Gracie.

Judge Brian Kelroy had a difficult task but his expertise helped him manage to make the final decision.

Kelroy grew up on his family’s Registered Holstein farm in Fond du Lac under the Kelroys Holsteins prefix. He has judged local, district, state and national shows throughout the country, and has also judged shows internationally in Australia, Japan, Peru and Poland.

Some of the highlights in Kelroy’s judging career are serving as the official judge for the 2018 Southern National Holstein Show, the Brown Swiss show at the 2018 International Dairy Week in Australia, the 2018 Wisconsin Championship Red and White Show, the Southern National Jersey Show, Mid-East Summer National Junior Holstein Show and serving as the associate judge for the International Red and White Holstein Show at World Dairy Expo in 2017.
